





Prioritised SDGs at the OIC Level





Other SDGs Covered in the 2021 Report



- In line with the UN methodology, our Report considers those indicators with two or more data points which are available for 50% (or more) of the OIC countries between 2000 and 2020 (or the latest available year).
- Among the 185 global SDG indicators allocated for the 14 SDGs covered, 73 indicators on which trend analyses were possible for the OIC countries group are included in the Report.
- The methods applied to show the progress of the SDGs focus on developments of the indicators and related goals over time.

Current SDGs Trends in OIC Countries



The OIC countries group will not achieve any of the above SDGs by 2030 unless the current pace of progress accelerates.




SDGs with Stagnant Progress






Proportion of Population below International Poverty Line (%), 2000 vs. 2018



Average proportion of the population living below the international poverty line in the OIC countries as a group, decreased almost by one-third during the period 2000-2018.




Under-Five Mortality Rate, Both Sexes (per 1,000 Live Births), 2000 vs. 2019



Average child mortality rate declined from 98 to 56 deaths per 1,000 live births between 2000 and 2019.




Adjusted Gender Parity Index for Completion Rate, Primary, 2000 vs. 2018



Average completion rates in primary and secondary education levels have also increased while the majority of the member countries with available data have achieved gender parity.



Proportion of Population Covered by at least a 3G Mobile Network (%), 2007 vs. 2019



Mobile services have spread much faster than anticipated between 2007 and 2019. Over 90% of people in 32 OIC countries had access to Internet services through a 3G network.



OIC Statistical Commission

- The only OIC cooperation platform among NSOs of OIC countries at DG/President level since 2011 for exchanging experiences and best practices to develop statistical capacities.
- SESRIC acts as the Secretariat and Rapporteur
- Organisation of annual main sessions with IsDB Group
- Regularly covering statistical issues related to the SDGs:
 - 9th Session (2020): SDG 1 (No Poverty) and Generating SDGs Indicators from Census Data
 - 10th Session (2021): SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being)

SESRIC StatCaB Programme



- A true South-South cooperation approach to capacity building for the NSOs of OIC countries since 2007.
- Matching needs and capacities of OIC countries based on the biennial questionnaire.
- Organisation of short term Statistics Courses, Study Visits, Workshops, and Webinars.
- More than 420 activities organised so far.
- 17 StatCaB activities on SDGs were organized including 12 statistical training courses and 5 webinars in collaboration with UN and other international organisations.



OIC Statistics (OICStat) Database

- First and only international official statistics repository covering all OIC countries.
- Currently hosting around 1,400 indicators under 26 categories dating back to 1970.
- SDGs category has more than 580 indicators periodically maintained to ensure the dissemination of most up-to-date data.
